

"Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and cover it with pitch inside and outside. This is how you are to make it: The ark will be 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high. You are to make a roof, finishing the sides of the ark to within eighteen inches of the roof. You are to put a door in the side of the ark. GENESIS

Make it with lower, middle, and upper decks.
"Understand that I am bringing a flood—floodwaters

on the earth to destroy every creature under heaven

with the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will

perish.



But I will establish my covenant with you, and you will enter the ark with your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives. You are also to bring into the ark two of all the living creatures, male and female, to keep them alive with you.



Two of everything-from the birds according to their kinds, from the livestock according to their kinds, and from the animals that crawl on the ground according to their kinds-will come to you so that you can keep them alive. Take with you every kind of food that is eaten; gather it as food for you and for them."


