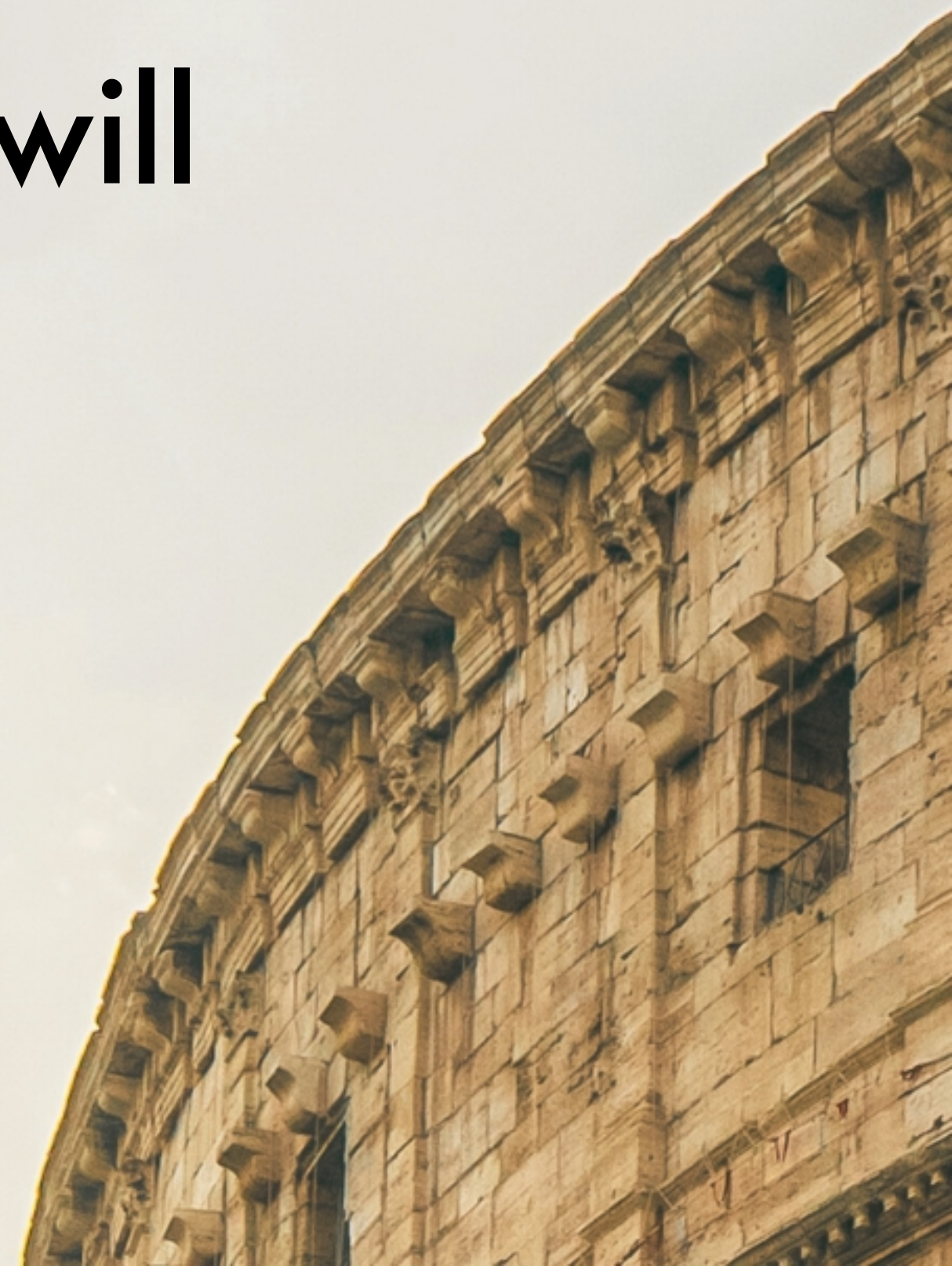
Genesis 3:13–15 CSB
